

2018 8th Grade OBX Trip

Students should be in the ERMS cafeteria between 5:00 and 5:15am on Wed., April 25th. All bags will be checked by chaperones. We will load the buses and leave by 6:00am.

Necessary Paperwork

- Each student **MUST** have Parental Permission Form and Medical Release form filled out and returned. Students will be given these forms next week
- Send only the amount of medicine your student will need for the time we are gone.
- All medicine **MUST** be labeled with student's name, dosage and time of dosage. Original prescription bottle is preferred and required for OTC medicines.
- Teachers keep all medicines and dispense as required.

What do students need to bring?

- Socks for bowling. We do not bowl in bowling shoes.
- School appropriate clothing for 3 days of activities. See itinerary.
- Personal products: Toothbrush/paste, deodorant, sunscreen, etc.
- A beach towel would be nice, but is not required. There will be beach time, but no one will be allowed in the ocean.
- Phones and other small electronic devices are allowed, but it is the responsibility of the student to take care of and keep up with these. School computers are not allowed. Only hand-held gaming systems are allowed.

- Drinks and snacks from home are allowed. **ONLY** drinks in plastic bottles with a **screw-on top** are allowed on the buses. Canned drinks are not allowed on the buses. (Bus Company Rule)
- No Monster, Red Bull or other energy drinks are permitted.
- Students should bring 1 suitcase with clothing. They can also have one carry on bag (tote, nylon sport bag, pocketbook) The suitcase will be under the bus and not accessible.

About Money: Very little cash is needed.

- All meals will be provided.
- Students will receive cash for purchase of lunch on the way to and from the Outer Banks. (\$10 each stop). Choices: McDonald's, Taco Bell, Subway, Bojangles
- Meals at the hotel are included and a restaurant lunch will also be provided.
- Drinks will be sold from the bus for \$1 each.
- There is an arcade and grill at the OBX Bowling Center. Each student will be given \$10 to spend at the bowling center.
- We will try to make a stop at a souvenir shop.
- We will return by 7:00pm on Friday, April 27th. We ask students to contact parents after the last rest area stop in Thomasville. We are approximately 2 hours away from ERMS at that point.
